Father Yeddanapalli Added To Canisius Chemistry Dept.

Liberatore, it has been announced by Father T. Joseph Brown, S.J., Chairman of the Department of Chemistry. Dr. Liberatore is on leave of absence from the college, with War Research Board at Columbia University.

Native of India
Born in Madras, India, Father
Yeddanapalli received his B. A. in
Chemistry in 1927 from St. Joseph's College, University of
Madras. He entered the Society
of Jesus in 1927 and made his
philosophical studies at Sacred
Heart College, Madras. His Master's degree was granted in 1935
at Calcutta University. In 1938
he was ordained after the completion of his theological studies at
St. Augustine College, Enghien,
Belgium,

Until forced to flee when the German Panzer Divisions invaded Belgium, Father Yeddanapalli conducted his studies and research at Louvain University. He completed his work and received his Ph.D. from Princeton University in 1942.

During his research, Father Yeddanapalli has written three
