

# Chemistry Department Re-Approved

The American Chemical Society's Committee on Professional Training, at its September meeting in Chicago, retained Canisius College on the list of institutions approved by the society for professional undergraduate education in chemistry.

In its reevaluation, the committee cited Canisius for having a chemistry program which "continues to meet fully the criteria of the American Chemical Society."

Furthermore, the committee commended Canisius College for

having "undertaken seriously to identify and analyze the objectives and programs of the College as they relate to available resources." The committee stated that the overall quality of the Canisius chemistry program "remains good."

Canisius College has been a member of the American Chemistry Society's approved list since 1960.

The head of the Canisius College Chemistry Department is the Rev. Ramon A. Salomone, S.J., associate professor.
